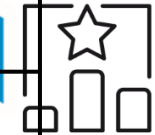
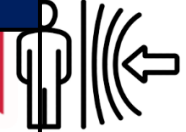


Core Values for

Resilience	<i>Resilience</i> is the ability to adapt and cope in difficult situations and have the confidence to seek support from others.	<p>Where does this apply in English?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Within English, students develop into independent, resilient, and thoughtful learners, but more importantly become life-long learners that possess the self-belief and skills required to fulfil their potential. • We teach students about the importance of a growth mindset. • Within our Mastery curriculum, we teach the importance of mastering a skill to enable students to overcome any difficulties faced within the subject.
Aspiration	<i>Aspiration</i> is the ability to form dreams, hopes, or ambitions to achieve a life goal.
