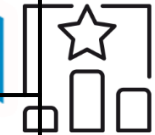
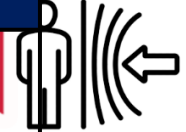


Core Values for

Core Value	Meaning	Examples
Character	<i>Character</i> is a set of personal traits or dispositions that evoke specific emotions, inform motivation and guide conduct.	<p>Where does this apply in MFL?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In MFL, we promote tolerance, acceptance and understanding through the teaching about other cultures. We aim to inspire students to develop multifaceted personalities interested in other cultures through the study of language.
Resilience	<i>Resilience</i> is the ability to adapt and cope in difficult situations and have the confidence to seek support from others.	<p>Where does this apply in MFL?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When faced with a challenging skill, we will encourage students to not give up and will support them to master it. We will develop the understanding within students that we can learn from mistakes and progress takes time. Students will be supported with nerves surrounding speaking and will be encouraged to overcome this when performing.
Aspiration	<i>Aspiration</i> is the ability to form dreams, hopes, or ambitions to achieve a life goal. Developing aspirations provides a sense of purpose and direction.	<p>Where does this apply in MFL?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will always encourage and provide students with opportunities to 'stretch' and 'challenge' themselves within lesson. Students will be made aware of how MFL links to employment. The importance of learning a language for the future are incorporated in every year of study.
