

## Progression Pathways Process

- Students have all been involved in assemblies regarding the pathways process.
- Students who were interested in participating in taster sessions have been given that opportunity to experience new subjects that have not previously been offered as a pathway choice.
- All students and parents have been invited to attend the Progression pathways Open evening on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> April from 4 – 6pm.**
- Students will make their choices by the deadline of Friday 26<sup>th</sup> April. Edge tutors will assist them in this and in entering the choices onto our on-line programme.
- Confirmation of choices will be communicated in June.

All students will study for at least **8 GCSE's**. This will include English Literature, English Language, Mathematics, Science (worth 2 GCSE's) and three additional choices.

Some students have been invited to study either French or Spanish and some students have been pre-selected for separate Science. All students will be issued with a paper pathways form which they can use to select their choices, if they have been chosen for a language or Science this will be pre-populated for them.

A copy of the form is included at the bottom of this document.

All students will need to choose at least one Ebacc subject and then at least two further choices. Ebacc subjects are Languages, History, Geography or Separate Science (Which is pre-selected only). These are subjects which give students a strong grounding in their studies now, and in further studies at KS5.

This will be further explained at our progression pathways evening.

Please make use of the guide which we have produced for parents and students which outlines all of the subjects that students will study in years 10&11. Core subjects are English, Maths and Science. Students also participate in statutory PE and Edge (PSHE).

We have also included some videos for some of the subjects which students can select for their additional choices. We hope these will be informative and helpful when making choices.

It is very important when thinking about the choices that students consider the fact that they will need to make reserve choices. Whilst every effort will be made to allocate all students all of their first choices it may not be possible and so students will be allocated their reserve choices.
