We had a lovely time at our Presentation Evening where we celebrated the achievements of our students!

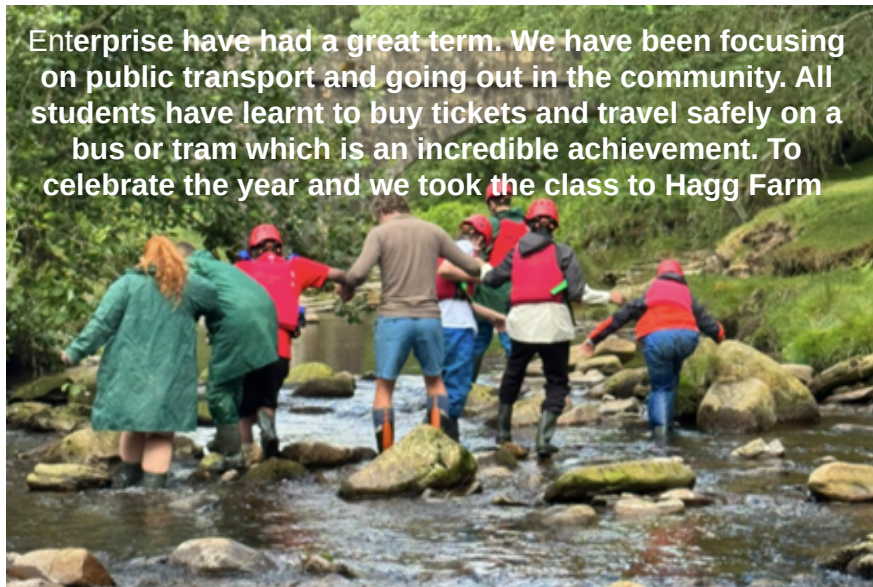


SQUIRRELS
