We really enjoyed practicing our cleaning skills, cooking, litter picking and bed making. Well done everyone!

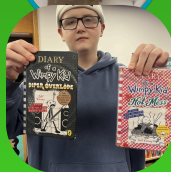
Challenger

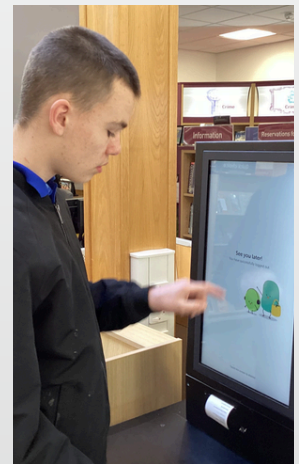
3S
