## The first morning

1:1/bespoke support. Facilitated by a teaching assistant.

## Leave of Absence in term time

**Term time absence - what you need to know:**

### **Curriculum Intent & Implementation**

Our intent is to ensure that all pupils receive the very best teaching and learning experiences across all subject areas. We believe that teachers teach best when they are both knowledgeable and passionate about their subject. To reflect this we have established Specialist Teaching Hubs and Immersive enrichment learning opportunities and Faculty Focus Days.



### **Subject Specialism and Teaching Hubs**

- Reflecting our visionary drive for academic excellence in all subject areas in September 2019 we introduced our Subject Specialist Teachers and Teaching Hubs.
- Following a model which we had successfully trialled we have created a Subject Specialist in each year group for the teaching and delivery of History, Geography and Science.



### **Faculty Focus Days**

- This is linked to the 'aspirations' element of our School Vision.
- As a result of our own observations, research and feedback and verified by the responses from local employers. We have introduced a whole school termly focus on 3 identified areas-Communication, Critical Thinking, Collaboration.
- This unique aspect of our curriculum is dedicated a weekly afternoon session – Faculty Focus – where pupils explore, investigate and discover through practical activities aspects of these areas.
- Term 1 –Communication
- Term 2- Critical Thinking
- Term 3- Collaboration

These sessions will be recorded in children's individual Career Passports.



## **Careers Passport**

• Each child will be given a Careers Passport, which will follow them through the school from Year 3 to Year 6.



- At the beginning and the end of each year, each child will identify three career options that appeal to them at each stage.
- Throughout the year, children will engage with a range of enrichment days, activities, visits and visitors to help to develop their aspirations.
- For each experience, children will be given a sheet with the title of the experience, a photo and a recount of what the experience entailed (produced by the class teacher).
- Each child will then complete their own reflections of the experience (what they enjoyed, what they learned, etc), and the impact it has had on their aspirations.
