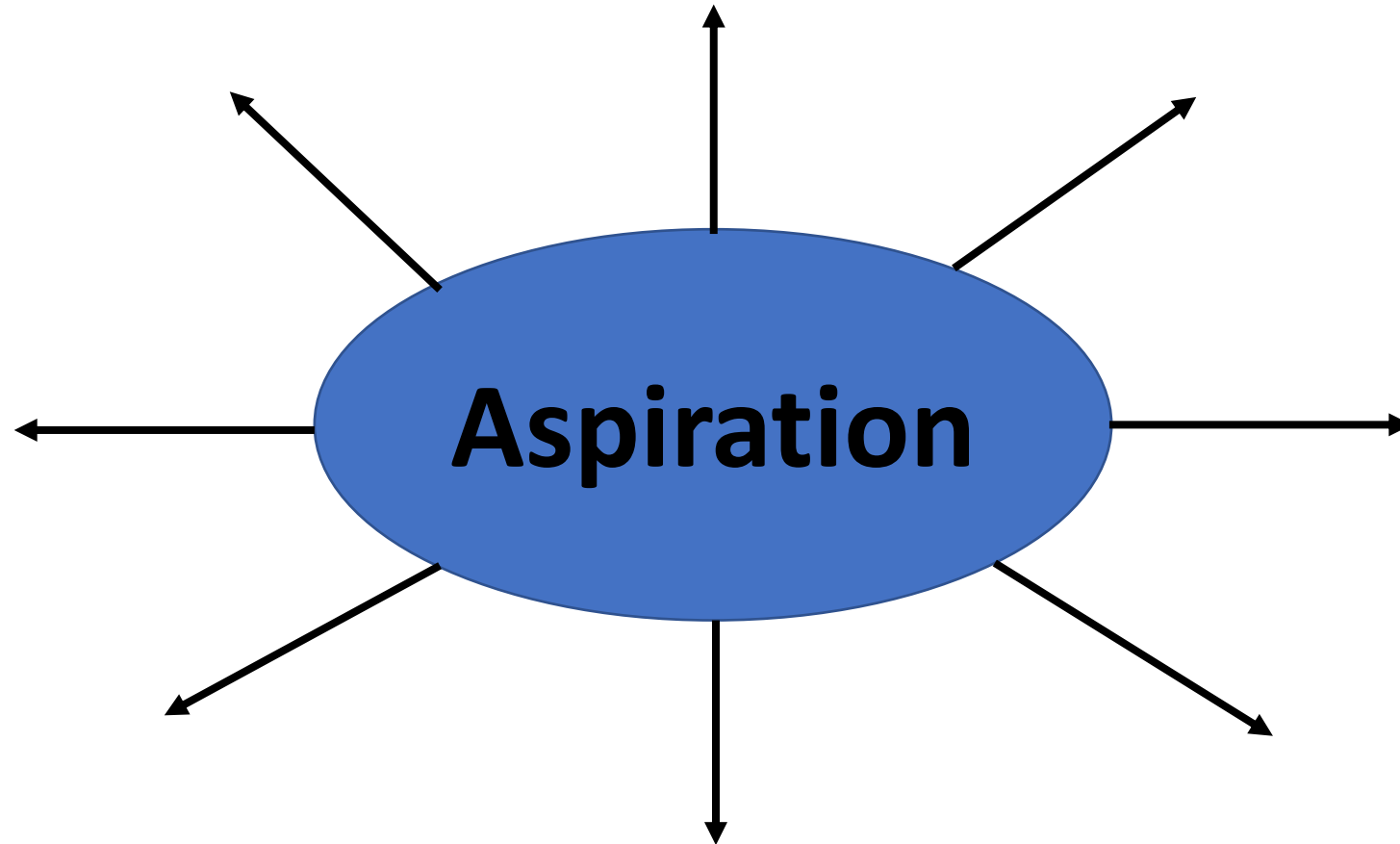
Why is it important to have aspirations?

...aspirations help us to develop as a person and to become the person we want to be

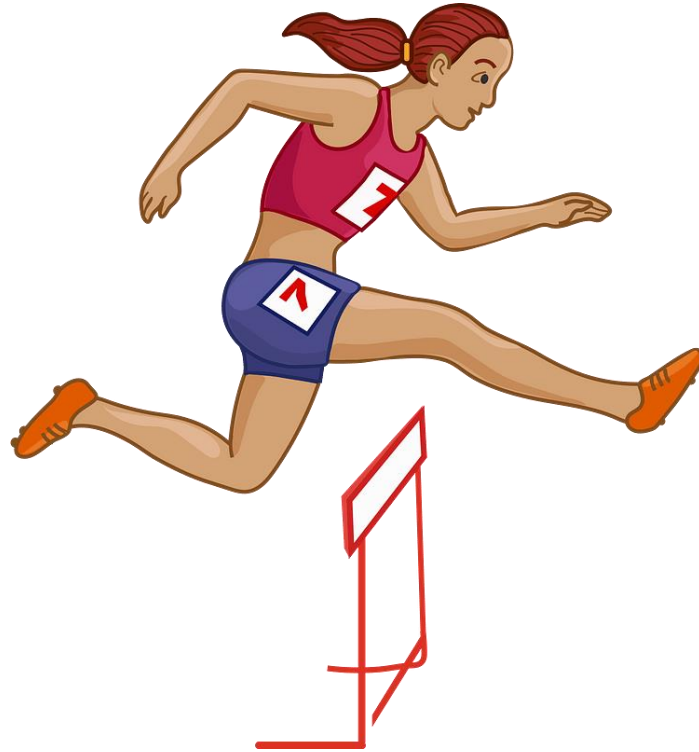

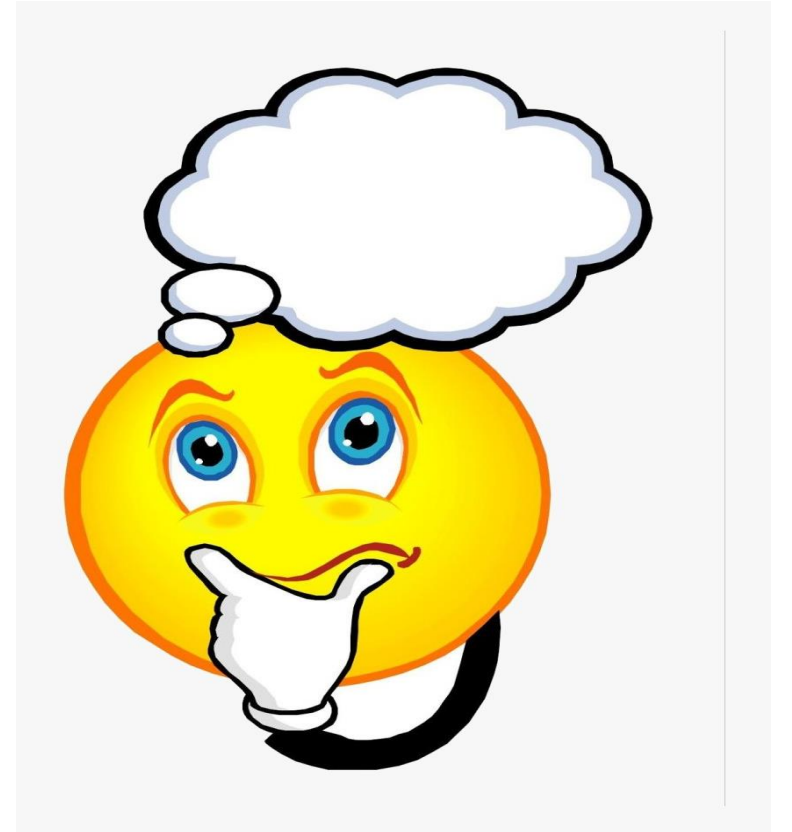


Many people **ASPIRE** to a particular job or career for example, nurse, teacher, vet, plumber, web designer, you tuber, professional athlete etc...
