Children may lead teams during English through the following:

Children can make choices through English by:

- Choosing which book to read after exposure to a range of texts and authors.
- Choosing vocabulary, language and structure which suits their audience and text type.
- Children can choose their own ideas for story planning.

Children will be independent during English when:

- Writing their own texts linked to a specific text type.
- Reading independently.
- Using a dictionary or thesaurus to spell, define or find synonyms.

The children can access real life through English by:

- Reading non-fiction based texts.
- Learning about real events through a range of texts and genres such as biographies or explanations.
