Terms	Online Safety Strand
Autumn One	<u>Self-Image and Identity</u> To know how to recognise that there may be people online who could make me feel sad, embarrassed, or upset and how I can get help from a trusted adult.
Autumn Two	<u>Online Relationships</u> To know that I should use the internet with adult support when communicating with people I know and why it is important to be considerate and kind to people online. <u>Online Reputation</u> To know what information, I should not put online without asking a trusted adult first as information can stay online and could be copied.
Spring One	<u>Online Bullying</u> To know how to behave online in ways that do not upset others and can give examples.
Spring Two	<u>Managing Online Information</u> To know how to use the internet to find things out using simple keywords in search engines. <u>Health, Well-being, and Lifestyle</u> To know how to explain that rules keep us safe when we are using technology both in and beyond the home.
Summer One	<u>Privacy and Security</u> To know how to recognise information that is personal to me (e.g., where I live, my family's names, where I go to school) and why I should ask a trusted adult before I share any information.
Summer Two	<u>Copyright and Ownership</u> To know how to explain why work I create using technology belongs to me and to know how to save my work so that others know it belongs to me (e.g., filename, name on content).
