We will be looking at the Bible and how It Is a special book to Christians. We will explore how the Bible has the Old and New Testaments.



Our learning will be focused on cooking and nutrition. We shall learn about where food comes from, what foods we get from plants and animals and what constitutes a healthy balanced diet. We shall also be learning about how to prepare healthy dishes. We shall also be discussing the important individual who made significant discoveries that impact our lives today.







History

Over the course of the term we shall know about the Victorian era. We shall learn about how Victorian seasides differ from 21st Century seaside's and how Victorian seaside and clothing has changed.





PSHE

Pupils will learn about different types of families and will delve into friendships and how to be a good friend. They will explore what makes a healthy, positive friendship and learn strategies to avoid or resolve conflicts effectively with others. Pupils will also be looking at how they can stay safe in all situations and the characteristics of friendships including mutual respect.





Music

Pupils will confidently use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

Homework

We recommend regular reading to be done at home – 2 times a week. Homework will be given on a Friday for the Wednesday after. The homework will be either Maths or comprehension based or sometimes both. We will also be sending home weekly a set of the Year 2 statutory spellings to learn. For book talk this half term we will focus on our English text The Lighthouse Keeper's lunch. Your child will have a variety of tasks to complete based on this book. A date to hand in book talk will be shared with yourself via dojo and in their book talk book.

PE

We will be engaging in the Net and Wall topic. Our focus will be on developing fundamental skills such as various throwing techniques and catching. Pupils will have the opportunity to practice holding a bat and striking a ball to a partner.

We will also focus on showing simple tactics in competitive fours and in a net/wall game.
