Summer 1 in Year 2



English

We will be looking at Animal Adventure stories, particularly the story of 'Mossop's Last Chance'.

The children will then write their own animal adventure story.

Phonics

The children will continue with the Read Write Inc Scheme. They will apply this learning to their reading and writing across the curriculum.

Maths

We will be looking at:

- Mass, Capacity and Temperature
- Fractions
- Time





Science

Our focus this half term is living things and their habitats. The children will be identifying animals and plants that live in certain habitats. They will Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. Furthermore, we will identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. The children will also be able to describe, how they obtain their food.

Our Value this half term

This half term we are looking at place knowledge. The children will understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom and of a small area in a contrasting non- European country.

They will also look at the Importance of sleep and dental hygiene. We will also explore a range of feelings and how they should respect everyone no matter their differences.

How does our curriculum link to our values?

- Music We will help each other learn the ukulele and support each other when things get difficult.





Computing

Homework

This unit introduces the learners to the term 'data'. Learners will begin to understand what data means and how this can be collected in the form of a tally chart. They will learn the term 'attribute' and use this to help them organise data. They will then progress onto presenting data in the form of pictograms and finally block diagrams. Learners will use the data presented to answer questions.

We recommend regular reading to be done at home – 2 times a week. Homework will be given on a Friday for the Wednesday after. The homework will be either Maths or comprehension based or sometimes both. We will also be sending home weekly a set of the Year 2 statutory spellings to learn. Your child will also receive their next book talk tasks soon. They will have a variety of tasks to complete based on this book. A date to hand in book talk will be shared with yourself via dojo and in their book talk book.
