Curriculum Implementation: how we do it at Gagle Brook

Each of our topics, is built upon from a termly, enquiry based question and our languages curriculum and appreciation of culture from around the world links in to this in a creative and engaging way.

Through a carefully crafted, active curriculum, our children will learn to:

- Speak, read and write in Spanish
- Immerse themselves in high quality Spanish texts and learn through songs and actions
- Discover the culture of the countries where Spanish is spoken- **Spanish** is the official or national language in Argentina, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Equatorial Guinea, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Puerto Rico, **Spain**, Uruguay, and Venezuela.

Enriching experiences such as learning about and embracing cultural festivals across the year through our curriculum, embracing the many languages within our community, celebrating International Mother Language Day across the school and extra-curricular clubs all add to the wide and varied languages curriculum open to all children at Gagle Brook.
