His classroom was so colourful and there were so many things to do! Everyone started the morning with sharing books on the carpet.

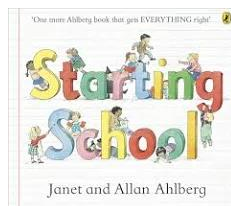
It made Teddy feel very calm.
