

Guided reading week commencing 22/06/20

L.O. Explore vocabulary in information texts and write summaries of information.

<p>Monday 22nd June 2020</p> <p>Have a think about these questions - <i>what do you know about trees already? What different types are there, what are the different parts of a tree and why are they important?</i></p> <p>Cover up everything apart from box one on page one of the Tree Dressing Day document and write anything you know about trees.</p> <p>Can you remember the VIPERS skills? These are: vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and summarising. It is important to remind yourself of these sometimes.</p> <p>Read box two and highlight any unfamiliar vocabulary, for example ecological, stabilising and ameliorating - <i>how can we guess the meaning of unfamiliar words?</i> Remember that we read around the word - the sentence or paragraph it's in. If this doesn't help, look it up.</p> <p>Covering up the previous two boxes, write a summarising explanation in box three about why we should protect trees.</p>	<p>Tuesday 23rd June 2020</p> <p><i>What can you remember about trees that we learnt yesterday? Did you learn any new words?</i></p> <p>Highlight or underline any unfamiliar vocabulary on page two and three of Tree Dressing Day as you read through it. For example, organisms, deciduous and photosynthesis.</p> <p><i>How could you guess the meaning of any unfamiliar vocabulary? Again, look anything up if reading around the word doesn't help you.</i></p> <p>Make a list of anything in the room you are in that you can see made of wood or paper (see page three exercise).</p>
<p>Wednesday 24th June 2020</p> <p>Think about everything we have learnt so far about trees and tree dressing day.</p> <p>Annotate page four of the document, labelling and writing summaries of explanations. You can add information if you want to, e.g. explaining that trees can be deciduous or evergreen.</p> <p>Perhaps you could present this information afterwards to a member of your household.</p>	<p>Thursday 25th June 2020</p> <p><i>What is Tree Dressing Day - when is it, what is the purpose of it and how do different countries celebrate it?</i></p> <p>Retrieve these facts from the text if necessary, then write a summary of Tree Dressing Day inside the leaf.</p>
<p>Friday 26th June 2020</p> <p>Spend some time looking at the leaf ID page, then match the leaves to the trees and colour-code as instructed.</p>	<p>Resources for children</p> <p>Page one of document Tree Dressing Day- Mon Page two and three of document Tree Dressing Day - Tue Page four of document Tree Dressing Day - Wed Page five of document Tree Dressing Day - Thu Page six of document Tree Dressing Day (plus Leaf ID page) - Fri</p>
