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Coordinates Spelling Game

Working with a partner, decide who will be noughts and who will be crosses. The first player needs to throw two dice and map the coordinate that they make on the spelling coordinate grid - the first die shows how far you need to go across the x-axis and the second die shows how far you need to go up the y-axis.

Using the silent letter word in the square, can you write a sentence using the word correctly? If you manage to create a sensible sentence, cross off that square using your chosen symbol. The first player to get three squares in a row is the winner!
