



Do you use childcare in Hertfordshire?

Do you have a child who will be 3 years old by 31 August 2016?

Working parents may be eligible for 30 hours **FREE** childcare (extended childcare entitlement) as part of our early delivery from September 2016 if:

- ◆ all parents in the household work the equivalent of at least 16 hours at national living wage or national minimum wage, therefore earning at least £107 per week
- ◆ no one parent in the family household earns over £100,000
- ◆ child lives no more than 2 miles from the childcare hub:
  - Batford Nursery School - Harpenden
  - Kingswood Nursery School – Watford
  - Rye Park Nursery School – Hoddesdon
  - Weston Way Nursery School - Baldock
- ◆ already accessing 16 hours per week or more of childcare or
- ◆ child was eligible to receive two year old free early education funding.
