#### **Sports Premium Funding**

The is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to provide sporting opportunities and encourage participation and interest in sporting activities both in and out of school.

**Sports premium** funding is available to both mainstream and non-mainstream schools, such as special schools and pupil referral units. It is paid to schools according to the number of pupils on roll.

#### What do we hope to achieve by targeting this funding:

- To use Sport as a vehicle for raising achievement and attainment in Literacy and Numeracy

#### What are we spending the money on and why?

#### 1) Sport Apprentice

We have appointed a sports apprentice to support all PE lessons. She is able to develop the subject and provide opportunities for participation at lunchtime and afterschool. Her training also allows the school to develop all areas of sport and offer alternative sessions in activities such as Dance, Zumba and Gymnastics. The sports apprentice team teaches PE with class teachers and leads small groups. She runs several clubs after school to provide further opportunities for participation in sport. She also leads the Sport leaders who provide activities for all the children at lunchtime.

# IMPACT-A PE specialist is now in every lesson supporting class the class teacher to deliver good quality lessons. Small group teaching can also take place to further develop skills.

#### 2) Resources

A full audit has taken place and resources have been purchased to ensure children can assess all the different activities. Playground equipment had also been purchased.

#### IMPACT-PE lessons and clubs are appropriately resourced.

#### 3) After school club support

Premier sport run an after school club weekly to complement our enrichment programme. They have run Rugby, Gymnastics and fencing which are proving to be popular.

IMPACT-Children have the opportunity to participate in a club led by a qualified coach.
