### **Sports Premium Funding**

The is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to provide sporting opportunities and encourage participation and interest in sporting activities both in and out of school.

**Sports premium** funding is available to both mainstream and non-mainstream schools, such as special schools and pupil referral units. It is paid to schools according to the number of pupils on roll.

- To use Sport as a vehicle for raising achievement and attainment in Literacy and Numeracy

### What are we spending the money on and why?

### 1) Sport Apprentice

We have appointed a sports apprentice to support all PE lessons. She is able to develop the subject and provide opportunities for participation at lunchtime and afterschool. Her training also allows the school to develop all areas of sport and offer alternative sessions in activities such as Zumba, dance and ultimate Frisbee.

# IMPACT-A PE specialist is now in every lesson supporting class the class teacher to deliver good quality lessons. Small group teaching can also take place to further develop skills.

### 2) PE leader

A middle leader has been appointed to ensure PE is planned and assessed appropriately. He is also responsible for enrichment and the provision of extra-curricular activities.

IMPACT-PE lessons are appropriately planned and children are assessed. All staff have class files. The profile of PE is high in the school and sport is valued. Children enjoy participating in a range of opportunities and understand the health benefits.

### 3) Resources

A full audit has taken place and resources have been purchased to ensure children can assess all the different activities.

### IMPACT-PE lessons and clubs are appropriately resourced.

### 4) After school club support

Premier sport run an after school club weekly to complement our enrichment programme. They have run Rugby and Gymnastics which are proving to be popular.

### IMPACT-Children have the opportunity to participate in a club led by a qualified coach.
