One particularly enjoyable event was delivered by Lancaster University School of Maths (LUSoM), known for its rigorous academic environment and focus on nurturing mathematical talent, delivered some dynamic sessions designed to challenge, inspire, and excite. Students explored topics beyond the standard curriculum, including logic puzzles, number theory, and real-world applications of abstract concepts. The class was led by Wing Liu, an experienced educator from LUSoM who brought energy, clarity, and a genuine passion for the subject.



Year 11 students had the opportunity to hear from a representative from Blackpool Sixth, who delivered an informative and inspiring assembly about post-16 options. The session highlighted the wide range of courses available, from A-levels to vocational pathways, and encouraged students to start thinking seriously about their next steps. Cardinal Newman College made a strong impression as staff visited GCA to host a lunchtime drop-in session for curious students. The event aimed to inform, inspire, and engage pupils as they begin to consider their next steps in education. And last, but by no means least the girls in Years 10 & 11 had the chance to attend an informative session delivered by Lancaster Girls' Grammar School (LGGS) - a fantastic option for post-16 education.
