



Distortion

(noun)

- The act of pulling or twisting out of shape.
 - OR
- The action of giving a misleading account or impression.
- **ETYMOLOGY:** from Latin *distortus*, past participle of *distorquere* "to twist different ways, distort," from *dis-* "completely" + *torquere* "to twist"
