Verb: completely remove or get rid of (something).

Etymology: mid 16th century (in the sense 'drive out'): from Latin *eliminat-* 'turned out of doors', from the verb *eliminare*,

from e- (variant of ex-) 'out' + limen, limin- 'threshold'.
