I hope you are all well and looking forward to the half-term break.

I wanted to share with you some more information about what we have been working on in school since I last wrote to you.

Oracy skills have been a key focus for us in school as we work hard to prepare children with skills for life. We have launched a strategy to ensure these skills are practised across the curriculum.

Our focus on reading and vocabulary also continues. All children in Key Stage 3 (Year 7 to Year 9) are enjoying our WIKI vocabulary programme, as we are developing skills to understand unfamiliar vocabulary. Why not ask them what is the best way to find out how many syllables are in a word? How do they know if a vowel is long or short? Which letter pretends to be a vowel? Through using words that are essential for the curriculum, we are supporting them to understand key curriculum vocabulary.


Children in Key Stage 4 (Year 10 to Year 11) have also been given a useful tool to master the Command Words in their GCSE exams. Ask them to show you how to use this resource to gain a deep understanding of how to master exam technique.

We have now come to the end of the first half of our Form Time reading programme. Miss Wild will be delivering assemblies after half term to launch the second round of books that children will read and discuss in form time, which can be seen below for Year 7.8.9 and 10.


