the arrival of a notable person or thing
 (In Christianity) the first season of the Church year,
 leading up to Christmas and including the four preceding Sundays.

Etymology: Old English, from Latin adventus 'arrival', from advenire, from (prefix0 ad- 'to' + (root word) venire 'come'
