#### (noun)

- the capacity to recover quickly from difficulties; toughness.
  - AND
- the ability of a substance or object to spring back into shape; elasticity.

**Etymology:** The word resilience derives from the **present** participle of the Latin verb resilire, meaning "to jump back" or "to recoil."
