



Autocratic

(adjective)

- Relating to a ruler who has absolute power.
 - AND
- Taking no account of other people's wishes or opinions; domineering.
- **ETYMOLOGY:** mid 17th century (in the sense 'autonomy'): from Greek *autokrateia*, from *autokratēs* (*autocrat*) **auto** (prefix) = self. **Cratic** (suffix) = relating to a particular government or rule.
