Student Equipment

We hope you and your families are all safe and well. During this unprecedented time, we have had time to consider the safe working practices of how student equipment will be distributed and how we will work following hygiene and PPE guidelines.

This year, we have collated a list of essential student equipment that will be required and used regularly by your child across the curriculum. We are asking that this list of basic equipment is purchased by yourselves before your child returns to school in September, most of which we advise purchasing ordinarily anyway.

The basic 'equipment' list to be purchased by Parent/Carer comprises as follows:

- Pens (Blue or Black Ink- at least 3)
- Green Pen
- HB Pencil
- 30cm Ruler
- Eraser
- Pencil Sharpener
- Mix of coloured highlighters
- Glue Stick
- Coloured Pencils
- Protractor
- Pair of compasses
- Scientific calculator available to purchase for £8 through ParentMail PMX Payments to ensure model is same as school/exam ones

Payments for calculators should be made through the PMX system by Monday 17th August 2020 for the order and delivery to be ready for September. It is appreciated that this is a quick turnaround however we are operating in a constantly changing environment.

For Year 7 new starters you will have the option to purchase a calculator through ParentMail PMX Payments as of Monday 7th September.
