



Re: Expression of Interest for the Boreatton Park Trip –
Wednesday 17th July 2024 – Friday 19th July 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

A reward trip to PGL Boreatton Hall in Shropshire has provisionally been booked for 17th July 2024 – 19th July 2024. The cost of the trip is £290 per student. The trip has 170 places for Year 8 Students and is a reward trip based on excellent attendance and excellent behaviour.

Boreatton Hall has a wealth of facilities at its disposal and 240 acres to explore. The on-site facilities are second to none and the grounds include a river, three lakes and abseiling towers. There are also five zip wires (including one across a lake), abseil towers, a high ropes course, Jacobs' Ladders, six giant swings and more. We will be staying in 4 - 6 bed lodges all en suite.

What's it all about?

It's about having fun while taking part in all sorts of adventurous activities designed to help your child learn and develop new skills and really shine as an individual and also as part of a team.

As this trip will take place in summer term and is a reward trip based on student's behaviour and attendance an expression of interest is required at this time. I need to know the numbers of students wanting to go on this trip. A deposit and payment schedule will be arranged and issued to parents. Students will be notified by the end of February if they have secured a place on the trip

What does it cost?

The cost per person is £290 which can be paid in installments prior to the trip.

The cost includes:

- Return coach travel from school
- A full daily programme of adventure activities
- Fun evening entertainment
- All meals and accommodation
- Full comprehensive travel insurance (details available on request or enclosed)

There are no extras, however if you wish, you can provide a small amount of pocket



money for your child to spend in the gift shop

The travel and instruction costs are considered to be 'a voluntary contribution from parents / carers'. However, it is important to state, that if these voluntary contributions are not made, and there was no way to make up the shortfall, then this residential activity would, regrettably, be canceled.
