

The Consequence System (The 'C' system)

Running parallel to Awards system is the school's Consequence system to address poor behaviour consistently across the school.

The system comprises 9 stages of consequence

C1 **Warning** Follow class rules...

If behaviour continues

C2	Behaviour logged on system	Progress Leader notified
-----------	-----------------------------------	--------------------------

If behaviour continues

C3 **'Moving-On'** 10 minute break-time

Progress Leader notified

If behaviour continues or failure to attend C3

C4	30 Min Lunchtime Detention	Progress Leader notified
-----------	-----------------------------------	--------------------------

Parents may be contacted

If behaviour continues & student sent to Subject Leader OR failure to attend C4 OR 2 x C4 in one week = C5 aswell!!

C5	1hr After School Detention	Progress Leader and SLT notified
-----------	-----------------------------------	----------------------------------

Parents WILL be contacted

If behaviour continues OR failure to attend C5

C6	Isolation	Only SLT can issue
-----------	------------------	--------------------

Progress Leader notified

Text home to parents

Meeting with parents for longer term/more serious

To be decided by Progress Leader/SLT

C7	Internal Exclusion	Progress Leader and SLT notified
-----------	---------------------------	----------------------------------

Meeting with parents

To be decided by Principal

C8	Fixed Term Exclusion	Progress Leader and SLT notified

C9 Permanent Exclusion

SLT will meet with Progress Leaders once every two weeks. Agenda items will include: Progress, Behaviour and Attendance. Within this agenda details of Awards and all Consequence 'C' data should be provided by the Progress Leaders for review. Minutes will be kept and an increased emphasis will be placed on communicating with parents.
