


| <p>Appreciation</p>  | To value differences between religions and culture | Differences, value, religions, culture |
| <p>Structures</p>  | The different parts of a religion (such as place of worship and key figures) | Religion, places of worship, church, mosque |
| <p>Significance</p>  | The importance of religion for people | Belief, religion, culture, importance |
| <p>Belief systems</p>  | A person's set of beliefs | Religion, belief, importance, Christianity, Islam, , |
| <p>Community</p>  | A group of people with the same beliefs or ideas. | Place, values, ideas, culture, |

| <p>Diversity</p>  | <p>Differences between or within religion or culture</p> | <p>Culture, religion, differences, similarities, food, celebration, clothes, beliefs</p> |

| <p>Symbolism</p>  | <p>Pictures or objects used to represent certain messages or stories.</p> | <p>Symbols, pictures, art, sacred books, representation, stories, importance, celebrations</p> |
| <p>Expression</p>  | <p>A way of showing your beliefs and ideals, through symbols, stories or the arts.</p> | <p>Expression, beliefs, symbols, stories, art, artists, importance, celebrations</p> |
| <p>Arts</p>  | <p>A form of expression of a person's religious belief.</p> | <p>Expression, art, belief, importance</p> |
