



<p>Cause and Effect</p> 	<p>How actions/events in the world can impact on humans and other living things</p>	<p>Human Pollution Environment</p>
<p>Significance</p> 	<p>The importance of geographical events (e.g. weather/seasons/pollution) on living things</p>	<p>Climate zones (e.g. tropical, polar)</p>
<p>Structures</p> 	<p>The human and physical features that make up an area</p>	<p>Human e.g. building, school, shops Physical e.g. mountain, river, coast</p>
<p>Influence</p> 	<p>The factors that contribute to change the environment.</p>	<p>Seasons, pollution, environment, human, physical.</p>
