


<p>Appreciation</p> 	<p>To recognise and value differences between religions, cultures, customs and beliefs.</p>	<p>Differences, value, religions, culture</p>
<p>Structures</p> 	<p>The hierarchy or make up of a belief system, place of worship and key figures.</p>	<p>Religion, places of worship</p>
<p>Significance</p> 	<p>The importance and impact of a religion on society and peoples lives.</p>	<p>Belief, religion, culture, importance</p>
<p>Belief systems</p> 	<p>The structure and interrelated nature of a person's beliefs or ideas (including non-religious.)</p>	<p>Religion, belief, importance, Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism</p>
<p>Community</p> 	<p>A group of people with a common set of beliefs or ideas.</p>	<p>Place, values, ideas, culture, together</p>

<p>Diversity</p> 	<p>Differences between or within religious beliefs or practices.</p>	<p>Culture, religion, differences, similarities, food, celebration, clothes, beliefs</p>
<p>Narrative</p> 	<p>An expression of the origin of religious beliefs or customs, including stories and the arts.</p>	<p>Stories, religion, expression, moral</p>
<p>Symbolism</p> 	<p>Pictures or objects used to represent certain messages or stories.</p>	<p>Symbols, pictures, art, sacred books, representation, stories, importance, celebrations</p>
<p>Expression</p> 	<p>A form of presenting religious beliefs and ideals, through symbolism, stories or the arts.</p>	<p>Expression, beliefs, symbols, stories, art, artists, importance, celebrations</p>
<p>Arts</p> 	<p>A form of expression of a person's religious belief.</p>	<p>Expression, art, belief, importance</p>
<p>Rituals</p> 	<p>Habits, customs or routines designed to demonstrate a person's commitment to their belief system.</p>	<p>Ritual, prayer, fast, celebration, commitment, charity Set of beliefs</p>
