

Travel Safety Protocols For All



To support us in creating an environment which is safe for all, we are asking that parents adhere to the following travel safety measures...

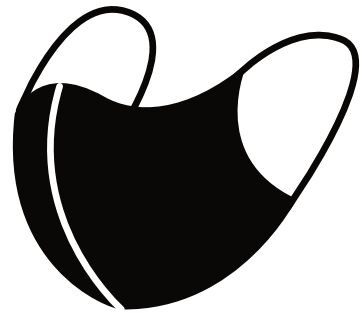


1.) ARRIVE TO SCHOOL ON TIME FOR THE WAVE OF ENTRY SELECTED

Arriving on time will avoid people queueing at entrance points if people are too early. Arriving too late will avoid the need to go via the school office where you will be asked to sign your child in.

2.) REDUCE THE POTENTIAL SPREAD OF VIRUS BY WEARING A MASK

As part of the national guidance, 'in public spaces where social distancing is not always possible' you must wear a face mask. We insist that this takes place on our school premises at entrance and exit points unless you are exempt.



3.) USE THE SCHOOL OFFICE NUMBER OR EMAIL TO REPORT ABSENCES OR TO SPEAK TO THE SCHOOL STAFF

This will avoid people needing to use the school office. Where people do need to use the office, only one person at a time will be admitted into this space and they will be asked to wear a face mask.

4.) CONTINUE TO USE OUR CHAPERONE SERVICES

These are run by our staff from 3 sites across the village.

The chaperone service is a great way to enable children to walk to school if you normally travel by car. This avoids the need to park on residential roads and allows for easier social distancing



5.) SUPPORT THE SCHOOL IN ITS HEALTH AND HYGIENE EDUCATION BY...

Ensuring your child sanitises their hands on entry into the school building, using sanitiser stations inside the school building and by washing their hands on their return home or to a new setting.

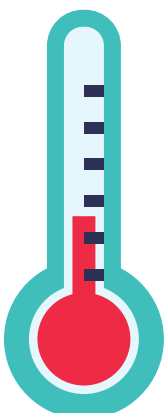
