Tamir Rice

Key Dates:

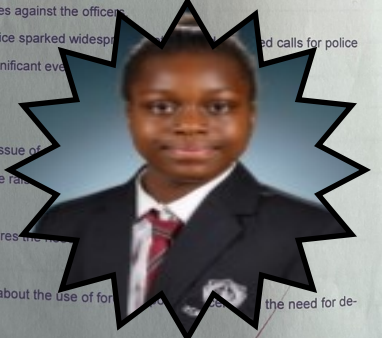
- 2014: Tamir Rice is fatally shot by police officers in Cleveland, Ohio.
- 2014: A grand jury declines to indict the officers involved in the shooting.
- 2016: The city of Cleveland agrees to pay \$6 million to Tamir Rice's family to settle a lawsuit.
- 2017: Timothy Loehmann, the officer who fired the fatal shots, is fired from the police department for lying on his job application.
- 2019: The US Justice Department closes its investigation into the shooting, stating that there is insufficient evidence to bring federal charges against the officers.

Additional Details:

- Circumstances of the shooting: Tamir Rice, a 12-year-old black boy, was playing with a toy gun in a park when police officers responded to a call about a man with a gun. The officers arrived and shot Rice within seconds of exiting their patrol car.
- Lack of indictment: A grand jury declined to indict the officers involved in the shooting, citing insufficient evidence.
- Lawsuit settlement: The city of Cleveland settled a lawsuit with Tamir Rice's family for \$6 million.
- Officer termination: Timothy Loehmann, the officer who fired the fatal shots, was later fired from the police department for lying on his job application.
- Federal investigation: The US Justice Department conducted a federal investigation into the shooting but ultimately decided not to bring charges against the officers.
- Public reaction: The shooting of Tamir Rice sparked widespread protests and calls for police reform and racial justice. It became a significant event in the fight against police brutality.

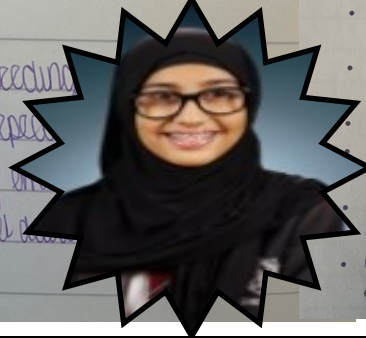

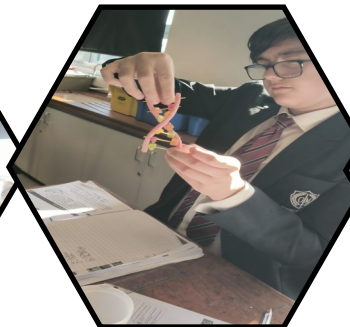
