 Nadia, whose older brother and sister are both at university, added: 'I didn't choose the school because Kate Middleton went there or Samantha Cameron. With respect to them, I don't want to be the wife of a king or prime minister, I want to be the prime minister myself.'
 She hopes to realise her dream of studying French at Oxbridge, and to eventually set up her own scholarship scheme for children from similar backgrounds.
