

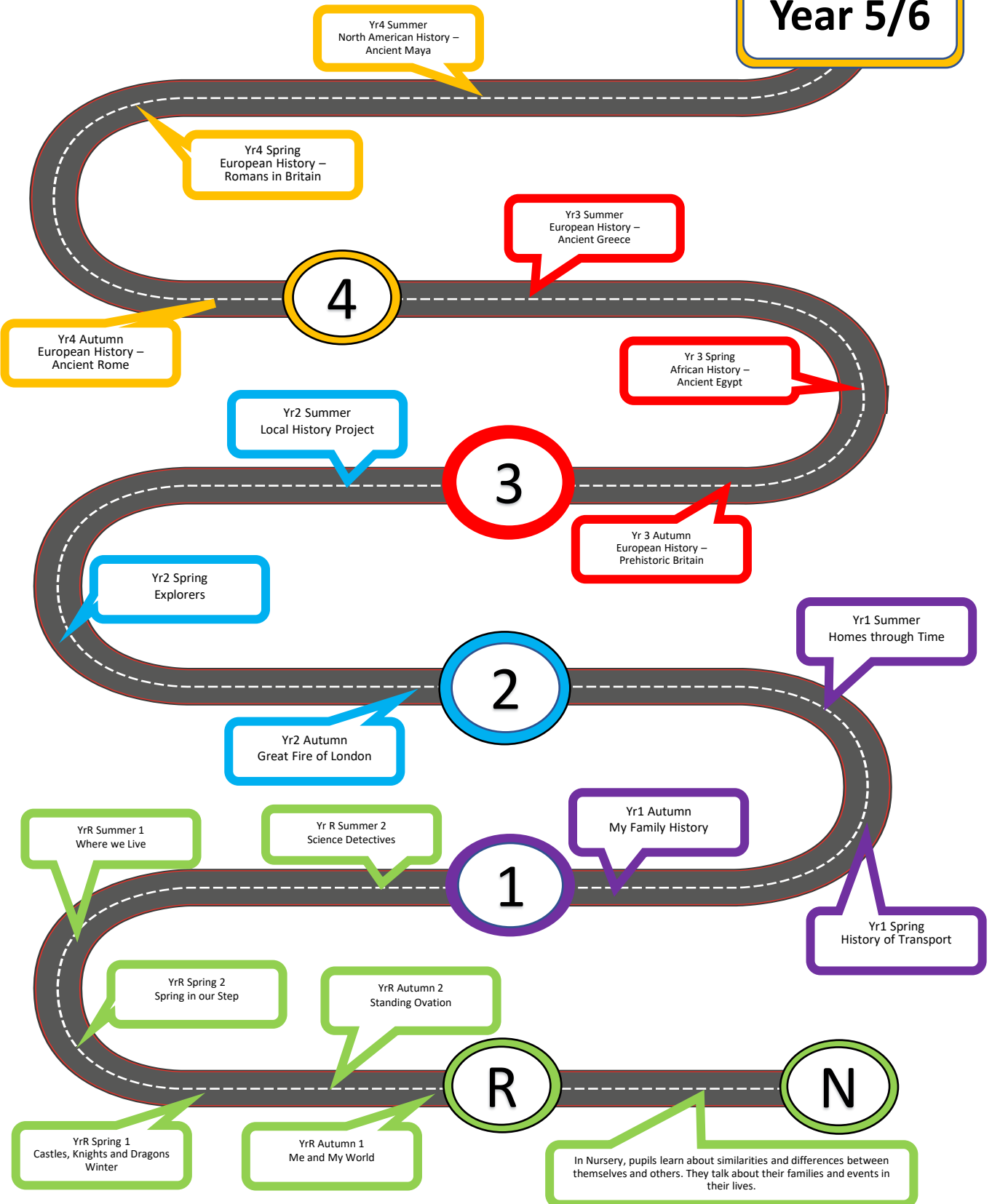
Subject Intent
