



## Whole class costume workshop

Run a whole class costume workshop with these resources

- assuming this is an afternoon session that's 2 hours long.

### Objectives


#### For the children:


- To consider how they would portray their own favourite book
- To create a costume element which supports their book recommendation.

### You will need

- Thin Card – enough for 30 at least A3 per child mainly white but some other colours could be handy too
- Elastic (for masks)
- Lolly Sticks
- White pillowcases (if you have them) If not white fabric we can cut into tabbards x10
- Sellotape – normal, double sided, masking and gaffa
- Glue (PVA if you have it)
- Decorative bits – sequins, beads, feathers (standard crafting/junk modelling stuff) (and containers or trays to put them out in)
- Foil or shiny paper
- Paints – water-based and fabric
- Pencils
- Rulers
- Paint trays and brushes
- Floor/table coverings
- Overalls

We got most of this list from a local scrapstore for less than £30.





### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Ask a grown-up to help cut out your inner and outer ears and head band templates.
2. Trace around your inner ear templates using a pencil on the light pink coloured card and cut them out.
3. Trace around your outer ear and head band templates using a pencil on the dark pink coloured card and cut them out.
4. Attach your outer ears to the top of the head band first using glue, then your inner ears on top of your outer ears.






# THE BIG BANG!

- Fun stuff to decorate with: Crayons, markers, glitter, stickers – get creative!




## Let's make cat ears

1. Print out the cat ear template and carefully cut along the lines.  
**No printer? No problem! You can draw your own cat ears straight to your cardboard**
2. Trace around your cat ears onto cardboard with a pencil and cut them out. Glue your paper and cardboard ears together to make them strong.
3. Use your crayons, markers, or glitter to decorate your ears.  
*Will you have grey fur like Rocky, white fur like Halo, or golden fur like Casper?*
4. Fold the Tab at the bottom of your ear away from the front.
5. Choose from Option A, B or C below to create a headband or crown that you can attach your ears to with glue or sellotape.

### Option A: Headband

Put some glue or sellotape on the folded tab of the ears and stick them to a headband. Press and hold until it sticks really well. Wait for the glue to dry completely before you wear them.

### Option B: Paper Crown

Cut a long strip of paper that goes all the way around your head.

It should be about two fingers wide. Stick the ends of the paper strip together with glue or tape to make a circle that fits nicely around your head.

Put some glue or sellotape on the folded tab of the ears and stick them to the paper crown. Press and hold until it sticks really well. Wait for the glue to dry completely before you wear them.

### Option C: Pipe Cleaners

Take 2 or 3 pipe cleaners and twist them together to make a circle that fits around your head.

Put some glue or sellotape on the folded tab of the ears and stick them firmly around the pipe cleaners. Press and hold until it sticks really well. Wait for the glue to dry completely before you wear them.






# HOW TO MAKE THE MASK

You will need: A4 paper, cardboard, glue, scissors, coloured pencils, wooden stick

## STEP 1

Print the first page on a piece of A4 paper. If you don't have a printer, follow the steps on the next page to draw your own mask.




## STEP 2



Glue the paper to a piece of cardboard.  
(Another piece of thick paper will also work!)

With an adult's help, carefully cut out the mask with a pair of scissors. Remember to cut out some holes for the eyes too.




## STEP 4

## STEP 5






1. Take a small paper plate.

# HANNAH GOLD

## BUILD YOUR OWN BEAR MASK



### YOU WILL NEED

- A cereal box or sheets of thick paper
- A pair of safety scissors
- A pencil
- A ruler
- Glue or sticky tape
- String (if you have some)

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRINTED MASK

#### BUILDING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Ask an adult to help you carefully cut out parts A/B/C/D/E along the solid dark grey line. You'll find this template on the following pages.
- 2) Fold along all of the light grey dashed lines in the direction indicated in the diagram below.
- 3) Find all of the small numbers on the tabs and edges of the individual parts of the mask.
- 4) Apply glue to the tabs and press firmly underneath the matching number, making sure the edges are aligned.
- 5) Fold parts D and E and stick to the top of the mask to make the ears.
- 6) Once your mask is complete, you could cut a band of cardboard from your cereal packet to fit around the back of your head and glue to the sides of the mask or attach a length of string or ribbon.


#### DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) If you want to draw, colour or paint your mask, it will be easier to do whilst the mask is flat.


# HANNAH GOLD

## BUILD YOUR OWN BEAR MASK



### YOU WILL NEED

- A cereal box or sheets of thick paper
- A pair of safety scissors
- A pencil
- A ruler
- Glue or sticky tape
- String (if you have some)



This line shows a Mountain fold (folds towards you)



This line shows a Valley fold (folds away from you)

### DIGITAL VERSION ONLY INSTRUCTIONS

#### DRAWING THE TEMPLATE


- 1) Take your cardboard or piece of paper and measure out a grid with 22 lines down and 19 lines across. Measure each line to be a distance of 1cm apart.
- 2) Following the diagram on the next pages on screen, count how many lines separate each point of the mask's shapes and make a dot. When you have marked out two dots, join them with a line using a ruler.
- 3) Once you have the outlines in place, use your ruler again to draw in all of the fold lines.

#### BUILDING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Ask an adult to help you carefully cut out parts A / B / C / D / E along the solid dark grey line.
- 2) Fold along all of the light grey dashed lines in the direction indicated in the diagram below.
- 3) Find all of the small numbers on the tabs and edges of the individual parts of the mask.
- 4) Apply glue to the tabs and press firmly underneath the matching number, making sure the edges are aligned.
- 5) Fold parts D and E and stick to the top of the mask to make the ears.
- 6) Once your mask is complete, you could cut a band of cardboard from your cereal packet to fit around the back of your head and glue to the sides of the mask or attach a length of string or ribbon.


#### DECORATING TEMPLATE

- 1) If you want to draw, colour or paint your mask, it will be easier to do whilst the mask is flat.



### CAN YOU CREATE YOUR OWN ANIMAL MASK?

Try placing the ears on top of the mask to turn the Bear into the Husky – or even try to create your own animal mask using the blank grid (HINT: you can design one half of the mask first to see if all of the pieces fit, then copy the design onto the second half of the grid).





## INSTRUCTIONS
