## Water Measuring

Using cups, jugs, and bottles can you experiment and find out about their volume and capacity.

How many cups does it take to fill a jug?  
What happens if you use a container with a smaller capacity?



## Melting Experiment

Find some different ingredients in your kitchen. Place them in a sunny spot and observe whether they melt.

How long did it take? (you could create a table to record your findings)  
Did they all melt? Why?



## Toy Rescue

Place some toys in containers of water and put them in the freezer overnight.

What happened?  
How can you save them?  
What was the most efficient method?
