What should I already know?

Nativity	The story of Jesus' birth
Christian	A person who believes in God and follows the teachings of Jesus
Bible	The special book read by Christians
Christmas	A festival celebrating the birth of Jesus
Wise Men	Visitors to the Baby Jesus who brought gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh
Mary	The mother of Jesus
Joseph	Jesus' earthly father


Step 4—Communicate
