

### What should I already know?

I am familiar with drawing, painting, collage and making, and with using basic art vocabulary such as colour, line, shape and texture. I have talked about your ideas, chosen materials, and looked at and responded to artwork through both play-based and structured activities.

### Vocabulary

bend	To gently curve or change the shape of paper (or other material) without folding or breaking it.
fold	To bend paper or another material so that one part lies flat over another part.
overlap	If two objects overlap, then one covers part of the other.
roll	To bend a piece of paper around to make a tube.
sculpture	Art in three dimensions.
scrunch	To squeeze or crush a piece of paper into a tight, crumpled shape using your hands.
spiral	A shape made up of curves.
3D	A shape that is not flat.
zig-zag	A line or pattern that looks like a Z or a row of Zs joined together.

### 1. Can I make a cylinder out of paper?

This sculpture is by Samantha Stephenson.



We can make a similar shape by rolling paper.



A sculpture is 3D art.

Let's make a sculpture out of paper tubes.

### 2. Can I shape paper to make a 3D drawing?

Think about what colours and shapes you want to use.



I can fold the paper to make zigzags or tables.

I can roll the paper to make loops or spirals.



Folding and rolling paper creates different shapes.

### 3. Can I create my own Tree of Life?



Different shapes can be used to portray different things. Patterns add more detail.

### 4. Can I work collaboratively to make a giant spider?

Work as a class to create rolls of newspaper and use tape to create a spider sculpture.



Paper shapes can be combined to make one bigger shape.

### 5. Can I paint a 3D surface?

Load a large brush with the right amount of paint and brush back and forth. Use a sponge to dab paint rather than dragging it across a surface.



Different brushes and sponges can be used in different ways for maximum coverage.
