What should I already know?

Vocabulary

Creation story	A story explaining how the world came into being.
Hindu	Hindus believe that life is a cycle of birth, death, and rebirth. They also believe that the next life depends on how the previous life was lived.
Christian	A person who believes that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and follows his teachings
Adam	The first man, created by God
Eve	The first woman, created by God.
Brahma	One of the three main god in Hinduism, the creator God.
Vishnu	Vishnu is the preserver of the world. His role is to return to the earth in troubled times and restore the balance of good and evil. He has blue skin and four arms.


