Belonging: Christianity

What should I already know?

- Christians' special book is the Bible
- Christians celebrate Easter and Christmas

Step 1—Communicate

I can talk about my own responses to *belonging*



I can name a group I belong to and explain how belonging to the group makes me feel.

Step 4—Contextualise

I can recognise how Christians show that they *belong* to the Christian Faith



Some Christians choose to celebrate belonging to the family of God by being baptised with water.

Vocabulary

belonging	Is the warm, secure feeling of being accepted, safe, and valued for who you are within a group, such as family, friends, or school.
church	A place where Christians worship God together.
prayer	Talking to God about things that are going on in our own lives or the lives of others.
baptism	A special Christian ceremony using water—either poured or through immersion—to symbolize washing away sins, starting a new life, and joining God's family.

Step 2 - Apply

I can identify how my response to the idea of *belonging* relates to my own life



I can talk about a time I felt I belonged and a time when I did not feel that I belonged.

Step 5—Evaluate

I can talk about the importance of *belonging* to Christians, and identify an issue raised.



Sometimes Christians might not feel they belong if someone says or does something unkind towards them.

Step 3—Inquire

I can identify and talk about the concept of *belonging*



Christians feel they belong to the family when they attend church services, worship together and pray to God.
