3. What human and physical features can we find in Edinburgh?



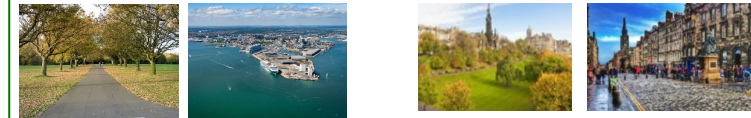
