What should I already know?

I know that mixing two colours creates a new colour.


I know that white makes a lighter tint of a colour.

I know that black makes a darker shade of a colour.

Vocabulary

mixing	Combining paint colours.
Primary colour	Red, yellow and blue; the colours from which all other colours are mixed.
Secondary colour	Green, purple and orange; colours made by mixing primary colours.
texture	A surface that is not flat
collage	Arranging different materials together and sticking them to a surface.
overlap	To partly cover something.
surface	the top layer of the artwork
detail	a small part of the whole artwork

1. What happens when I mix two primary colours?




4. Can I create a collage from my collage paper?
