notes	A sound used to create a melody.
tempo	How fast or slow a piece of music is.
melody	The main tune of a piece of music. A sequence of musical notes arranged in a rhythm.

1. How does music make you feel?

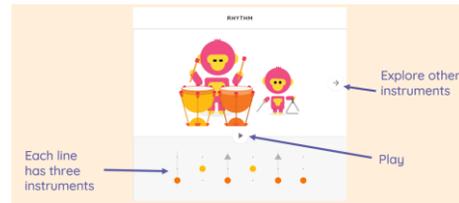


Gustav Holst wrote music about the planets to make us think and feel different things.



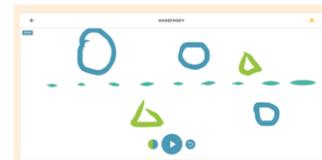
Music can make us feel different emotions. These can be described using adjectives. We like some pieces of music more than others.

2. Does music have patterns?



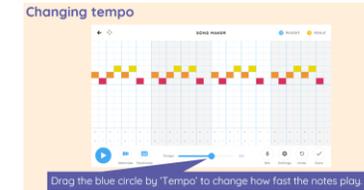
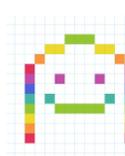
Chrome Music lab is a program that lets you create digital music. You can create rhythms using digital instruments

3. Can you experiment with sound using a computer?



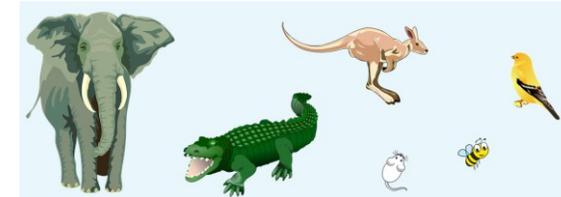
In Chrome Music Lab the pitch of a note can be changed by positioning the lines or shapes high or low. The instrument can be changed using the 2 colour button

4. Can computers create musical patterns?



Songmaker on Chrome Music Lab lets you create musical patterns. You can place notes, change instruments and change the tempo. Tempo is the speed of the music.

5. Can you create music for a purpose?

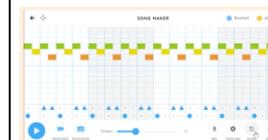


How does your animal move?
