

Going to Glenfield



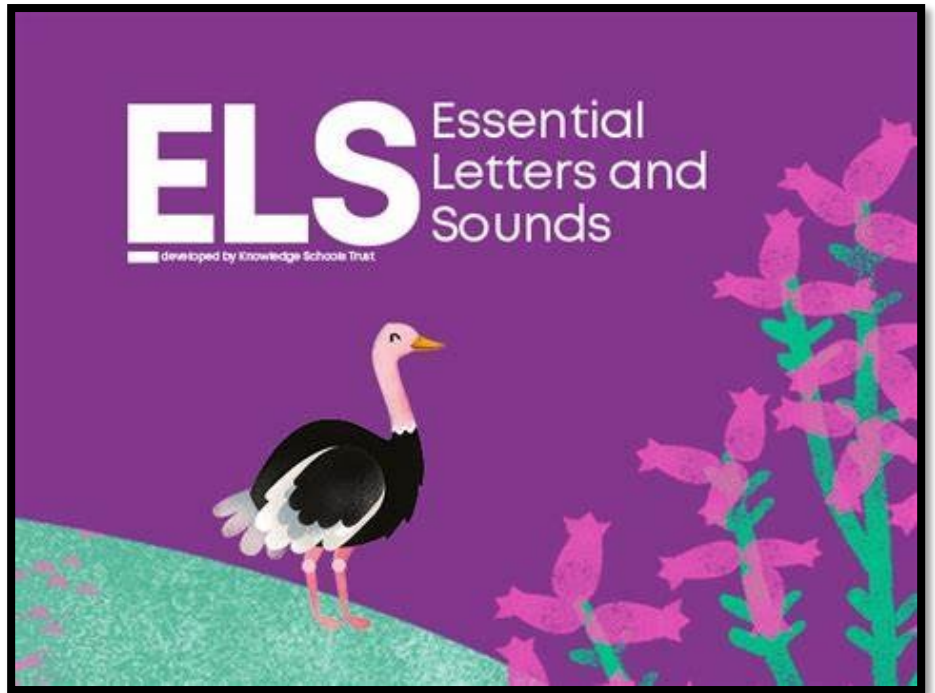
I will come into class

read.

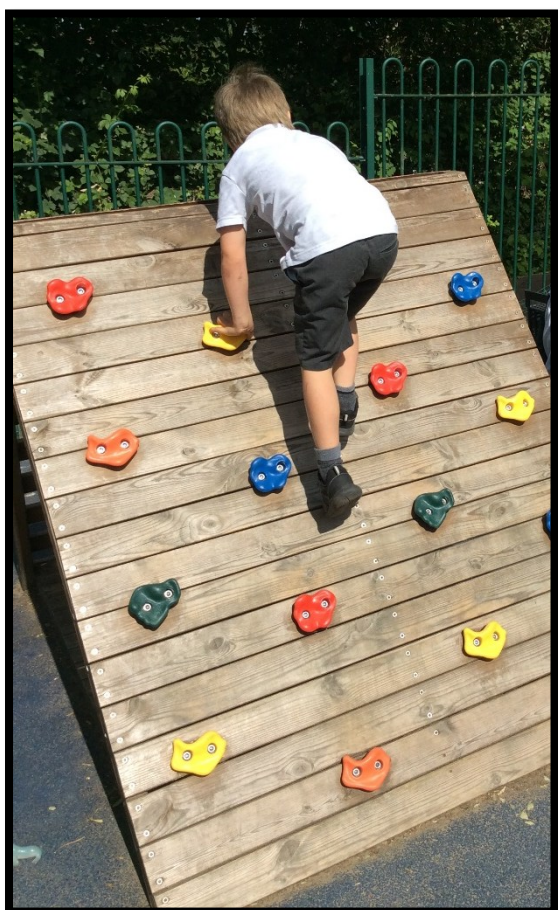


After this I will normally have a snack of a piece of fruit and milk (free until 5) or a drink of water from my bottle.
