

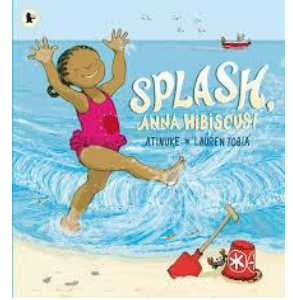


The Nest Newsletter – Summer term One

Key texts:

This term children in our Nest will be focussing on the key text “Anna Hibiscus -Splash!” by Atinuke and Lauren Tobia. We will be sequencing stories and thinking about understanding the questions why and how.

We will be learning that there are different countries in the world, thinking about similarities and differences as well as naming some features such as land and sea. We will also talk about holidays.

We will be thinking about other peoples feelings, talking to start to deal with conflict and taking turns, using stories to help.
