## MATHS

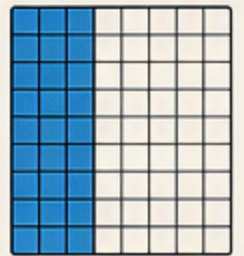

Our History focus in the second half of the term will centre around the plague and the village of Eyam.

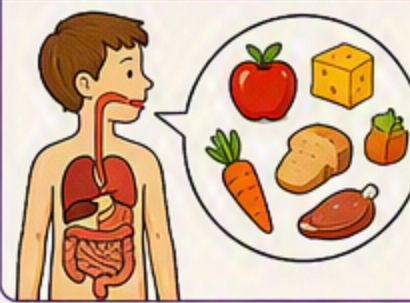


## SCIENCE

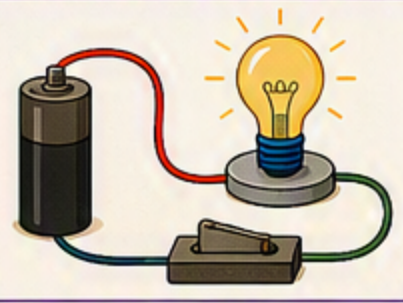


In the first half of the Autumn term we will be looking at Animals including humans: Digestion and food. We will then turn to look at electricity and circuits in the second half of the term.
