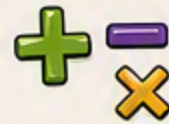
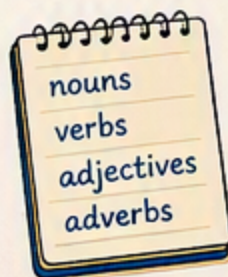
Autumn term 2026

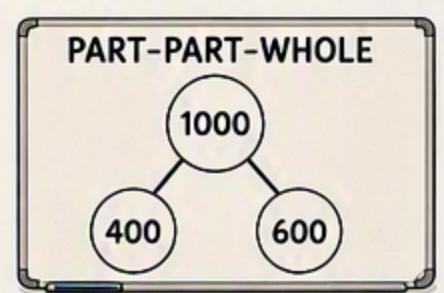


MATHS

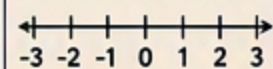
