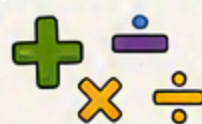
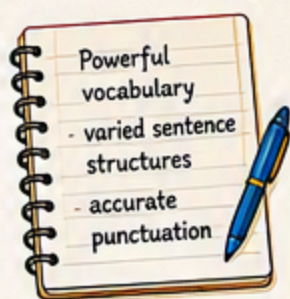
Autumn Term 2026

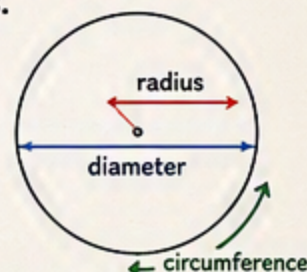


MATHS



In Maths, we will be looking at numbers up to 10,000,000. Recognising the place value of each digit as well as looking at decimal fractions. We will also be exploring multiplication and division and learning about the different parts of a circle. In the second half of the term we will move on to look at fractions and percentages.

THEME



- We begin our new term with a focus on P.S.H.E, where the children will be exploring their aspirations for the end of Year 6 and for their future. The children will be attending a careers fair in school, having the opportunity to speak to various people in a variety of different professions. 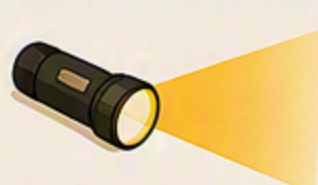
