

# Year 1 Newsletter

## Summer Term 2 2022

### Maths

In Maths we will be learning about the place value of numbers up to 100. Children will be partitioning, comparing and ordering numbers as well as finding one more and one less. Children will study the 100 square and learn how to use it effectively.

Following this unit, we will move on to money. Children will learn to recognise coins and notes and count money.

Later in the term they will learn about time. They will learn about dates, telling time to the hour and half hour and writing time.

### English

In English our key text is 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon. Children will be writing their own stories with a dilemma and learning to use new vocabulary effectively. They will continue to use simple sentences but will learn to expand these using conjunctions such as 'and' 'but' 'so' and 'because'. Children will be discussing the events, characters and plot, making predictions and answering some inference questions.

We will continue with daily phonics sessions.



In Science this term, we are learning about animals and humans. Children will learn about growth, basic needs, exercise, food and hygiene



## Theme

In History our key question is – **How does a young man from Tameside become and national sporting hero?**

In this topic children will learn about Geoff Hurst.

After looking at the chronology of events, children will learn about his early life – growing up in Tameside and how he came to play for England.

They will learn about the world cup event and the impact this had on his life and on sport and England today.



Sir Geoffrey Charles Hurst MBE is an English former professional footballer. A striker, he remains the only man to score a hat-trick in a World Cup final, when England recorded a 4–2 victory over West Germany at Wembley Stadium in 1966.

Please continue to complete the homework set on Class Dojo and practise the spellings set.

Please read regularly with your children and read the book more than once developing fluency and confidence. Ask your children some questions to check their understanding.

Also – read to your children – this allows them to listen, relax and develop a love of books.
